Creates the Advanced Directive for Health Care Act; relates to living wills; provides the format for a living will; provides that any person of sound mind who is emancipated or 18 years of age or older may execute a document which appoints a health care agent, directs the withholding or withdrawal of life-sustaining procedures or the withholding or withdrawal of the provision of nourishment or hydration when the declarant is in a terminal condition or state of permanent unconsciousness, or covers both.
