Provides for certain records access for family of deceased unless limited by the provisions of a legally valid psychiatric advance directive, to a surviving spouse of the recipient or to the individual or individuals most closely related to the deceased recipient within the third degree of consanguinity; provides that a limitation in a psychiatric advance directive does not prevent a surviving spouse or qualifying relative from receiving access to information needed for the purpose of applying for benefits.
